
The Young Brian Lenihan also distinguished himself on the sports fields of Ireland, playing for Westmeath minor gaelic football team, captaining the UCD soccer team, playing for Athlone, Bohemians and Shelbourne and winning Amateur International Caps at centre forward against England and Scotland.

At University College Dublin he was a gifted student attaining B.A. Honours in Economics, Politics, and Law in 1951. He practised as a Barrister from 1952 to 1961.

He married a local Athlone girl, Ann Devine, in 1958.

They have five children, four sons and a daughter. The oldest, Brian junior, is a barrister in Dublin, Conor, a radio journalist, Niall a lawyer in New York, Paul and Anita are still at school.

The Lenihans are a close-knit family despite the rigours and separations during Brian Lenihan's
