31,765 people died in 2020 of all causes. This is the white area at the top of the bar chart on the left. This represents just **0.6%** of the total population.

Most of these deaths were from

- cancer (9356)
- heart diseases (8744)
- accidents and suicides (1250).

COVID Deaths in 2020

According to the CSO, only **0.04%** (1672) of people died with COVID. Most of these people were elderly with serious underlying health conditions.

This is represented by a barely visible thin red line at the very top of the bar chart.

For this relatively very small number of 'COVID-deaths' the country has suffered unnecessary lockdowns, freedoms removed. the economy wrecked, hundreds of thousands of incomes and jobs devasted, billions added to the national debt, hospital waiting lists have been allowed to skyrocket and the mental health of hundreds of thousands of people severely damaged.

WHAT'S HAPPENNING?




WHY IS THIS DANGEROUS?
